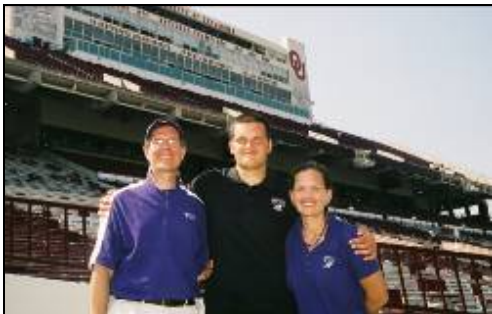
Bryan Cortney, B.A., TCU
